SMALL GENERAL SERVICE**

AVAILABILITY

Available to Consumers for commercial, industrial, multi-phase farm service, and all other non-residential service for all uses including lighting, heating and power subject to the established rules and regulations of the Cooperative.

TYPE OF SERVICE

Single and three-phase, 60-cycles at available secondary voltage. Motors having a rated capacity in excess of ten horsepower (10hp) must be three-phase.

MONTHLY RATE

- A. Basic Consumer Charge:  
Basic Consumer Charge: \$ 14.00 per billing month
- B. Plus Demand Charge:  
First 20 kilowatts of billing demand per month – No Demand Charge  
All kilowatts of billing demand in excess of 20 - \$16.32 per kW
- C. Plus kWh Charge:

- D. The minimum charge per month or fraction thereof shall be the highest of the following:
- (1) The Basic Consumer Charge - \$14.00/month, or;
  - (2) The Demand Charge in B above for (a) 70% of the highest monthly billing demand established during the preceding calendar year, or (b) 70% of the Consumer's requested capacity, or;
  - (3) The minimum specified in the contract of service.

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BILLING DEMAND

The billing demand shall be the maximum kilowatt demand established by the Consumer for any period of fifteen consecutive minutes during the month for which the bill is rendered, as indicated or recorded by a demand meter and adjusted for power factor as follows:

POWER FACTOR ADJUSTMENT

The consumer shall at all times maintain unity power factor as nearly as practicable. The Cooperative reserves the right to measure the power factor at any time. Should such measurements indicate that the power factor at the time of the consumer's maximum demand is less than eighty-five percent (85%) the demand for billing purposes shall be the demand as determined above, multiplied by 85% and divided by the percent power factor.

TEMPORARY SERVICE

Temporary service shall be supplied in accordance with the foregoing rate except that the consumer shall pay in addition to the foregoing charges, the total cost of connecting and disconnecting service, less the value of materials returned to stock. A deposit, in advance, may be required of the full amount of the estimated bill for service, including the cost of connection and disconnection.

SERVICE AT PRIMARY VOLTAGE

If service is furnished at primary distribution voltage, a discount of five percent (5%) shall apply to the demand and energy charges. However, service may be metered at secondary voltage and adjusted to primary metering to account for the transformer losses in consumption and demand by the installation of Transformer-Loss Compensators.

SPECIAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS

- (1) Meter readings may be billed in units of 10 kWh.
- (2) Meters to be read by consumers except special cases where read by the Cooperative.

In addition to the above, the general Terms and Conditions for Supplying Electric Service of the Cooperative, as filed with the West Virginia Public Service Commission, shall apply.
